Chapter IV. Municipal Court

§ 13-4-1. Selection.

The Judge of the Municipal Court shall be appointed by the Council upon formal application, upon the basis of his qualifications, and after a merit interview with the Council.

§ 13-4-2. Qualifications.

At the time of his appointment and during his term of office, the Judge of the Municipal Court shall not be a member of any Town or state central committee of any political party, and shall be barred from contributing to any political candidate or party.

§ 13-4-3. Compensation.

The salary of the Judge of the Municipal Court shall be determined by the Town Council.

§ 13-4-4. Ordinance.

The Town Council shall determine all other matters related to the Municipal Court by ordinance, consistent with state law and the provisions of this section.
