



10. After November 13, 2000, plaintiff will not be regularly employed by the town.
11. Plaintiff has no other pension or service allowance from the town. She is not a member of the Municipal Employees Retirement System, R.I. GEN. LAWS §§ 45-21-1 *et seq.*
12. Other employees of the town who have received service allowances or pensions from the town have contributed 6% of their yearly salary to partially off-set the cost of participation.
13. Plaintiff has contributed 6% of her yearly salary for the entire period of her tenure as a town councilor.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff requests that the Court enter a declaratory judgment, declaring that upon her retirement from the Town Council, and so long as she is not otherwise regularly employed by the Town, plaintiff is entitled to a service allowance under Westerly Code, § 2-143, in the amount of \$2800 per year.


CONSENT JUDGMENT

DECLARED:




